Free Throws Push Valpo Past IPFW

Fort Wayne, IN -Valparaiso made the most of their 41 free throw attempts to hold off IPFW, 75-67 on Monday night at the Memorial Coliseum.

The Crusaders (2-0) knocked down 31 of their tries, many down the stretch to open up a very close contest.

The first half set the tone for the entire game. There were three ties and two lead changes, with the largest lead of the half (5) belonging to Valpo with just 3:03 remaining.

The Crusaders maintained the lead in the second half until junior guard Chris Perkins knocked down a three to give the 'Dons a 45-44 lead at the 12:39 mark.

IPFW senior guard Quintin Carouthers brought the Coliseum crowd to their feet with a baseline drive and slam, but the 'Dons trailed by one (61-60) with 4:19 left.

The game would end up getting away from IPFW (0-2) at the 1:54 mark. The 'Dons were down 64-61. Junior forward DeWitt Scott was at the line shooting one and the bonus, but Scott missed the front end. Valpo grabbed the rebound, ran the floor, and got the ball to Huff, who buried a triple to put the Crusaders up by six.

IPFW was led by junior forward Zeljko Egeric with a career-high 17 points on 5-8 shooting from the three point line.

Scouting the Warriors

So Far in 2006-07

The Warriors are now 3-1 on the season after a 103-44 win over Ohio State-Marion on Saturday night.

Leading the Warriors

Senior guard **Brent Wichtner** (6-3/North Branch, MI) leads the Warriors in scoring. Coming off the bench, Wichtner is averaging 15 ppg. Bookend forwards **William Goree** (6-5/Sr./Madison Heights, MI) and **Tyler Leipprandt** (6-4/Jr./Ubly, MI) average 12 points and 7 rebounds a contest.

Last Time Out

Rochester College obliterated OSU-Marion 103-44 in their last game. Wichtner came off the bench to lead the Warriors with 18 points and four assists. Goree chipped in 17 points and seven rebounds. Leipprandt was the third of four players in double-figures with 15 on 6-8 shooting.

vs. Spring Arbor

Rochester's only loss came at the hands of Spring Arbor. The Cougars topped the Warriors 70-65 on 10/31. Wichtner again led the Warriors with 21 points, drilling four triples. Leipprandt recorded a double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds, and Goree added 10 points and seven boards.

Who They Are

Rochester College is part of the United State Collegiate Athletic Association (USCAA). The same conference as future opponent Marygrove.

The Coach

For the past 33 years, Garth Pleasant has been a head men's basketball coach.

Earlier this season, Pleasant won his 600th ballgame, making him the winningest coach in the state of Michigan.

This is his 27th season at Rochester College. He guided the Warriors to National Championships in 1989, 1997, and most recently in 2004. He is 3-3 in National Championship games, and his teams have reached the post season in 22 of 26 seasons.

So Far in 2006-07

The Mastodons are 0-2 after dropping a 75-67 decision to Valparaiso on Monday night at the Memorial Coliseum.

Leading the Mastodons

Junior forward **Zeljko Egeric** (6-9/230/Split, Croatia) is averaging 14.0 points per game. He also is averaging 4.0 rebounds a contest. Senior guard **Quintin Carouthers** (6-4/185/Flint, MI) is averaging 7.0 points per game and 3.5 rebounds. Junior point guard **Chris Perkins** (6-2/190/Villa Park, IL) rounds out the top-three in scoring at 7.0 ppg. He averages 4.5 board a game.

vs. Valparaiso

The Mastodons let one get away late vs. the Crusaders. Another sub-par shooting night (37.3%) and 17 turnovers hurt the 'Dons chances of winning. IPFW did rebound the taller Crusaders (38-36) with Tyler Best grabbing a team-high 10.

"Z" en fuego

Egeric has found his scoring touch. The "Croatian Sensation" drilled 5 triples against Valpo. He hadn't hit a three-pointer in a game since his freshman year. The lone triple of his career came on 11/30/04 at UTEP. "Z" has led IPFW in scoring both games so far this season.

Independent's Day

This will be the final season of Independent play for IPFW. The Mastodons will join North Dakota State and South Dakota State as new member of the Mid-Continent Conference beginning in the fall of 2007. Last season, IPFW was 6-5 against fellow Independents.

The Coach

IPFW is led by 2nd year head coach **Dane Fife**. He led the 'Dons to a 10-18 record in his first year on the bench. Fife, at 27, is the youngest coach in Division I basketball. Fife began his career on the staff of former head coach Mike Davis at Indiana. He served as an assistant for two seasons before coming to IPFW.
