Texas A&M Corpus Christi Wins First-Ever Division I Independent Tournament Championship

OREM, Utah--Texas A&M Corpus Christi won the first-ever Division I Women's Basketball Independent Championship by defeating Northern Colorado 62-42 on March 4 at Utah Valley State's McKay Center. With the victory, the Islanders finished the regular season with a program-best record of 22-6, while the Bears fell to 12-16.

Kirbria Lewis, who was named the tournament MVP, scored a season-high 19 points, made five steals and grabbed four rebounds, while backcourt mate Nicole Duncan hit five three-point baskets to finish with 15 points. She added four steals. Kayla Flavin led UNC with nine points

Pair of 4.0 GPAs Highlight 2004-05 Division I Independent Women's Basketball All-Academic Team

FARGO, N.D.—With a pair of 4.0 grade-point averages, University of Texas-Pan American's **Stacey Gooden** and North Dakota State University's **Lacey Johnson** highlight the 19-member 2004-05 Division I Independent Women's Basketball All-Academic team released Wednesday, March 9.

Each of the 10 Division I Independent schools have at least one representative on the all-academic team. The Division I Independent Women's Basketball All-Academic team was selected by sports information directors at member institutions. Nominations from each school were accepted for student-athletes who had at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA, had reached at least a sophomore athletic standing and were a starter or key reserve for the team.

The team was comprised of five seniors, nine juniors and five sophomores.

The cumulative GPA of the all-academic team was 3.658.
