Offensive Player of the Week

Fabiana Souza • MH • Sr. • Belo Horizonte, Brazil • IPFW

Souza is currently averaging 5.29 kills/game after four matches and has a .391 hitting percentage. She is just 95 kills away from IPFW's career kills record of 1,895. In the Hofstra Invitational, Souza had two matches of 20+ kills and was named MVP of the tournament.

Defensive Player of the Week

Maegan Hoyt • L • Sr. • Eden Prairie, Minn. • Utah Valley State

Hoyt started where she left off last season solidifying the back row for Utah Valley State. In two matches against Big 12 power Kansas and Big Sky foe Montana State she notched 42 total digs, averaging an impressive 5.25 digs per game, and 21 digs per match. Against KU she had 13 digs, and against MSU she finished with 29 digs. Hoyt's dig total of 29 in the MSU match ranks second in Utah Valley State history for a single match. She was just four digs shy of her own record of 33 set against Northern Colorado last season.

Setter of the Week

Lacey Koelliker • S • Jr. • Las Vegas, Nev. • Utah Valley State

Koelliker continued to be solid for the Wolverines after having been a big part of the offense for the past two seasons. Against Big 12 power Kansas and Big Sky foe Montana State Koelliker notched 79 total assists, averaging 9.88 digs per game and just under 40 assists per match. She also kept the defense off balance with 13 kills and a .333 hitting percentage.

Newcomer of the Week

Liz Franz • OH • Fr. • Littleton, Colo. • Northern Colorado

Franz averaged 1.33 kills, 1.33 blocks and 0.56 digs per game last week as the Bears lost to Boise State and defeated Wyoming at the UniWyo Cowgirl Classic. Franz had three kills, four digs and three blocks in the four-set loss to Boise State and bounced back with a career-match against host Wyoming. Franz set career-highs in kills (9) and blocks (9) in helping the Bears to their first victory of the season (after starting 0-3).
