Offensive Player of the Week

Fabiana Souza • MH • Sr. • Belo Horizonte, Brazil • IPFW

Souza played outside hitter against NDSU but was moved back to the middle against SDSU. She led the IPFW in kills both matches with 19 against NDSU (6.3 per game) and 23 against SDSU (4.6 per game). She averaged 5.25 kills per game. For the week she combined for a .280 hitting percentage (42-14-100) and also had 18 digs and two block solos and five block assists.

Co-Defensive Player of the Week

Danielle Holthe • MB • Sr. • Covina, Calif. • Texas-Pan American

Holthe set a milestone this past week as she became the program's all-time leader in block assists with 215 in her career, surpassing the old mark of 214 set in 1996 by Lisa Yanez. The UTPA senior accomplished the mark against Utah Valley State when she collected three block assists and one solo blocks for a total of 4.0 blocks in the match. Holthe collected 11 kills, four service aces, three digs and one block against Texas State (Oct. 4) then followed up for a quartet of blocks against Utah Valley State (Oct. 8) to go along with eight kills and a pair of service aces.

Co-Defensive Player of the Week

Abby Mayne • L • So. • Greeley, Colo. • Northern Colorado

Mayne averaged 5.44 digs/game last week as the Bears were 2-0 with wins at fellow D-I Independents South Dakota State (3-2) and North Dakota State (3-1) as the Bears hit the .500 mark (9-9) for the first time this season. She had 28 digs (one off her career-high) in a five-set win at SDSU and followed that up with 21 digs in the four-set win at NDSU.

Setter of the Week

Chelsea Blakely • S • Fr. • Houston, Texas • Texas-Pan American

In two matches this past week, Blakely collected 104 total assists, averaging 13.0 assists per game. The Lady Broncs newcomer finished with a match-high 55 assists to go along with 10 digs against Texas State (Oct. 4) then added 49 assists and 18 digs on the road at Utah Valley State (Oct. 8). Against the Wolverines, Blakely also added three blocks and two service aces. The UTPA freshman accumulated two double-doubles (assists-digs) in a pair of matches this past week and ups her double-double total to four this season.

Newcomer of the Week

Kellie Phillips • OH • Fr. • Chandler, Ariz. • Texas-Pan American

Phillips was the Lady Broncs' top offensive threat this past week as she recorded 41 kills in two matches, averaging 5.13 kills per game. She collected a career-high and match-high 22 kills versus Utah Valley State (Oct. 8) to go with seven digs, two blocks and one assist. She posted a hitting percentage in that match of .269 in 52 total attacks. Phillips posted a team-high 19 kills against Texas State (Oct. 4) along with six digs, one service ace and a single assist.
