**Fabiana Souza • MH • Sr. • Belo Horizonte, Brazil • IPFW**

In winning the award for the third consecutive week, Souza helped IPFW improve to 18-4 last week, piling up 58 kills (4.83 kills/game) in the Mastodons wins over IUPUI and Chicago State and five game heart-breaker of a loss to Eastern Michigan. She led IPFW with 25 kills against EMU and had 12 against IUPUI and 21 against Chicago State. She also contributed on the defensive side coming up with 37 digs and 10 blocks.

Jankowski accumulated 68 digs (5.67 digs/game) leading IPFW's defensive effort in its three matches last week. The 5-7 libero has helped the Mastodons to a top-30 national ranking in team digs per game for most of the season and has become IPFW's most steady passer in serve receive.

#### Setter of the Week

Koelliker led Utah Valley State to a 1-1 finish last week, with a loss to #15 BYU and a win over fellow Division I Independent Northern Colorado. Koelliker recorded 95 assists in two matches (11.88 a/g). She also had 9 kills and hit a timely .346. Against UNC she tied her own school record (for the third time this season) with 65 assists and helped four Wolverines have double-digit kills. As a team the Wolverines hit .218 in the five game match. Against #15 BYU she had 30 assists and 4 service aces.

#### Newcomer of the Week

**Kellie Phillips • OH • Fr. • Chandler, Ariz. • Texas-Pan American**

In winning the award for the third consecutive week, Phillips was the top offensive performer for the Lady Broncs as she collected 41 kills, averaging 4.10 kills per game, in three matches this past week. She also notched 35 digs, averaging 3.50 digs per game. She posted a double-double (kills-digs) in two matches on Saturday (Oct. 22) with 10 kills and 11 digs against Prairie View A&M followed by a team-high 18 kills and 16 digs versus TCU. She nearly missed her seventh double-double against Prairie View A&M as she recorded 13 kills and eight digs.
