Why make a course portfolio?

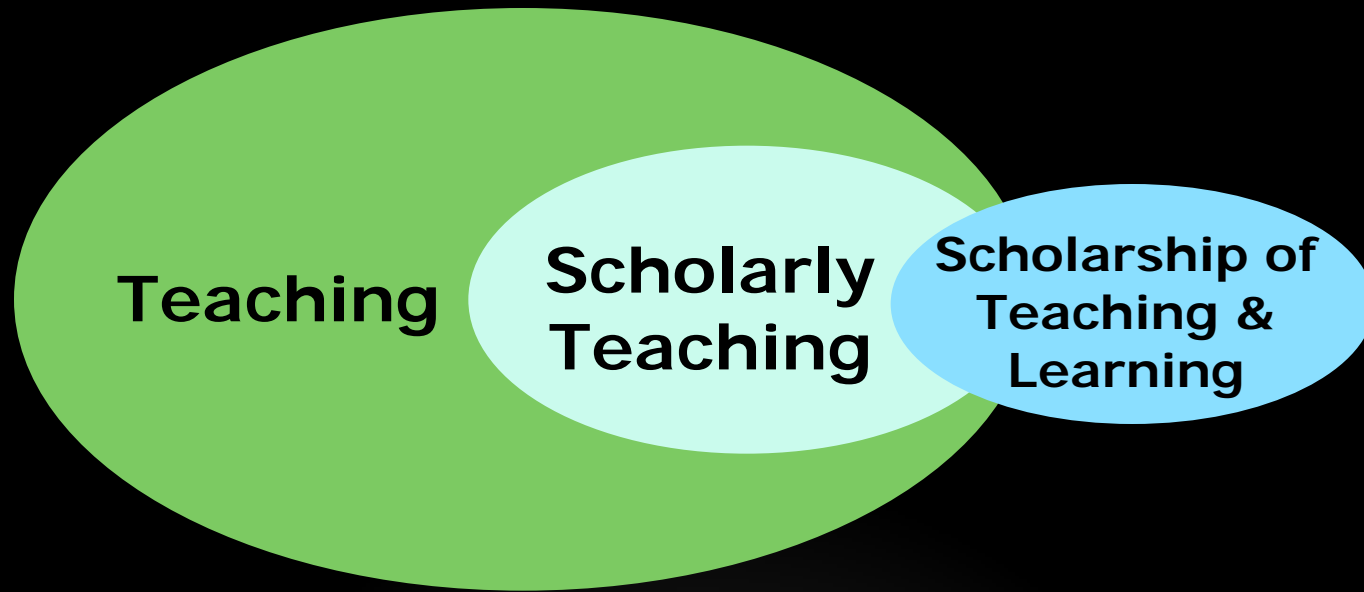
