To be considered for summer financial aid, you must:

- _____ Be regularly admitted to an IPFW degree program
- _____ Have the 2007-08 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the IPFW Financial Aid Office (FAO).
- _____ Have the FAFSA received by the FAO prior to the last week of classes or June 14, 2008, whichever is earlier.
- _____ Have all verification requirements completed prior to receiving summer aid.
- _____ Be registered for at least 6 credit hours (undergraduate students) or 4.5 credit hours (graduate students)
- _____ Have the 2008 Summer Application Form turned in to the IPFW FAO by June 14, 2008 for Summer I and July 26, 2008 for Summer II.
- _____ **For Pell Grant calculation purposes, you must be registered for all expected hours by May 16, 2008. Your Pell award will not be changed for classes that are registered after this date.**

Aid Programs Available – Requirements & Policies

Federal Pell Grant

- _____ To be eligible, you must have remaining eligibility from your 2007-2008 Federal Pell Grant award.
- _____ If you have attended full time both fall and spring semesters, you **will not** have remaining eligibility.
- _____ The amount of the Federal Pell Grant award depends on remaining eligibility and your enrollment status for summer.
- _____ If you are an undergraduate student, you may be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant with an enrollment of less than 6 credit hours.
- _____ **For Pell Grant calculation purposes, you must be registered for all expected hours by May 16, 2008. Your award will be recalculated if you fail to attend Summer II. This is required by federal regulations and the recalculation may result in you having to repay part of or all of your award.**

Federal Subsidized & Unsubsidized Stafford Loans

- _____ Federal Stafford Loans are made by participating banks, credit unions, or savings & loan associations.
- _____ If you have already borrowed your maximum annual loan limit for the 2007-08 academic year, you **will not** be eligible for a Federal Stafford Loan for summer unless you have advanced a grade level.
- _____ You must be enrolled in a **total** of 6 credit hours throughout *one or both* summer sessions to be eligible for loans.
- _____ If you are a first time loan borrower or a new student to IPFW, you must submit a Master Promissory Note and Entrance Interview Counseling either online or in written form – directions on Entrance Counseling will be mailed to you.
- _____ A Master Promissory Note will be available to submit electronically through your lender's website.
 - _____ All student loans are disbursed in one check according to the loan period.
 - _____ Deadlines for processing Federal Stafford Loans are:
 - Summer I only: June 20, 2008
 - Summer I & II only: August 1, 2008
