



## HONORS PROGRAM

### SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

This scholarship will pay up to \$600.00 in tuition for one honors class (excluding H-Options); students currently conducting their honors project may apply the equivalent amount toward supplies for their project. Applicants must currently have a 3.5 or greater GPA, nine (9) or more honors credits, and must intend to complete the IPFW Honors Program requirements. Preference will be given to applicants who have not previously received a financial award from the Honors Program.

The scholarship is merit-based, and shall be awarded by **a panel appointed by the Honors Program Director**. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

- Clarity of writing
- Merit, as demonstrated by the essay submitted
- Merit, as demonstrated by the accompanying recommendation letters

Applicants should submit a double-spaced typed essay no longer than two (2) pages outlining their accomplishments and how they perceive the Honors Program's contribution(s) to their success. In addition, a letter of recommendation from one of the student's instructors should be included.

Entries, including the student's name, address, and contact information, and recommendation letter should be sent to the Honors Center, WU G25 no later than **October 30, 2006**. Awards will be announced by November 20, 2006.

All entries become the property of the IPFW Honors Program and may be published and/or used for promotional purposes. The number of awards bestowed each year will vary according to available funding.
