Indiana University–Purdue University Fort Wayne ([IPFW](http://www.ipfw.edu)) is a joint campus of two internationally recognized universities. IPFW is a public/state university that grants bachelor's degrees (www.ipfw.edu/academics/programs/undergraduate) and master's degrees (www.ipfw.edu/academics/programs/graduate) from Indiana University and Purdue University in more than 200 academic options. The university is nationally and internationally accredited by variety of professional societies including The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools and The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB).

The city of Fort Wayne is the second largest city in the state of Indiana. It is located in northeastern Indiana and is within a two-to-three hour driving distance from major cities (Chicago, Illinois; Detroit, Michigan; and Indianapolis, Indiana). The city of Fort Wayne has its own airport, Fort Wayne International Airport (FWA). The IPFW campus is located near shopping malls, movie theaters, restaurants, and hotels and is easily reached by the public bus system.

IPFW provides strong education in a variety of areas with reasonable costs. **The cost of tuition, mandatory fees, housing on campus, health insurance, food, and personal expenses is estimated at \$24,000 U.S. dollars per academic year (9 months).** Additionally, IPFW is one of the very few universities in the United States to offer partial scholarships to international students. The Chancellor's Merit Award is awarded to 25 international students every year based on the student's academic records. The **maximum annual value for award is about \$6,500 a year and renewable** for up to eight semesters (4 years).

IPFW offers state-of-the-art [Student Housing](http://www.ipfwstudenthousing.com) facilities with a beautiful and high quality apartment living style **without** food services and with convenient access to campus (www.ipfwstudenthousing.com). Due to the limited number of rooms available on campus, all students are urged to apply to Student Housing as soon as possible to reserve rooms before they are filled. Private housing off campus and within 10 minutes walking distance is available with a reasonable cost to IPFW students.

[IPFW](http://www.ipfw.edu) accepts students based upon their academic achievements, English language proficiency, and financial documentation. However, intermediate English as Second Language (ESL) courses are available to international students. In order for an international student to secure admission to IPFW, the following documents **MUST** be submitted to the International Student Services (ISS) office at the address listed below.

- 1- Completed international student application with \$30 USD non-refundable fee
- 2- Proof of English proficiency, which includes one of the following: TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, ACT, Michigan Test, EIKEN, etc. for non-native English speakers
- 3- Original or certified copies of all secondary and post-secondary academic records and degree certificates. All academic documents must be submitted both in the original language and in English.
- 4- Biographical statement of about 300 words
- 5- Two (2) letters of recommendation from your teachers/professors or work supervisors
- 6- Proof of financial support (i.e., an official letter or statement from a bank, company, or government sponsor, indicating the availability of sufficient funds to pay for your tuition and living expenses)

ESTIMATED COST OF ATTENDANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FOR 2008-2009 ACADEMIC YEAR (per academic year (9 months) in U.S. dollars)

Tuition, Taxes & Mandatory Fees	\$13,991
Room (to live in university's dorms with quad occupancy)	\$4,710
Health Insurance (if not covered by other comparable health insurance)	\$900
Estimated Unbilled Cost (Food (\$1800), Books (\$1300) & personal expenses (\$1000))	\$4,100
TOTAL Estimated Billed & Unbilled Costs	\$23,701

The billed cost listed above is based on registration of 13.5 credits a semester and DOES NOT take into consideration Chancellor Merit Award that may be awarded. Therefore, The actual billed cost depends on the value of the award and number of credit hours pursued each semester.

Chancellor Merit Award is awarded to 25 international students every year based on the student's academic records. Awards are determined by a thorough review of the information provided on the International Student Application and the required supporting documents. The **maximum annual value for award is about \$6,500/year and renewable** for up to eight semesters.

As with any college or university, there will be additional unbilled costs: supplies, entertainment, clothing, transportation, visit a home for vacations, etc. The total amount for unbilled costs will vary depending on each student's lifestyle.

Students can expect that the cost of attendance will rise by 2% to 3% each year of enrollment.
