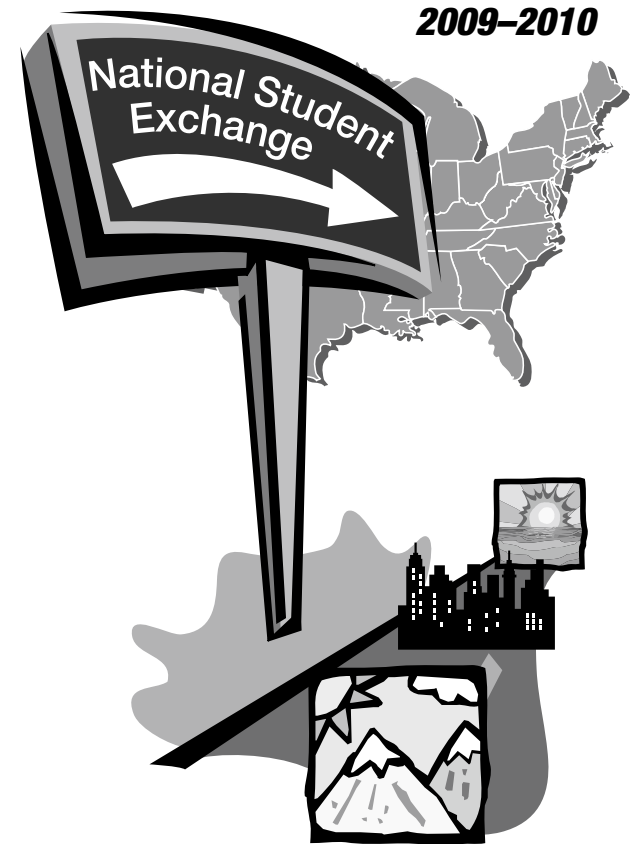

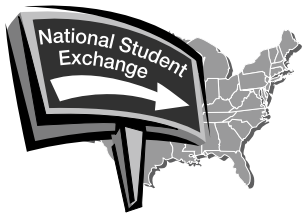

National Student Exchange

The National Student Exchange (NSE) offers you the opportunity to continue making progress toward your IPFW degree while spending a semester or academic year at one of 190 other U.S. and Canadian colleges and universities, at a cost similar to what you are paying to attend IPFW.

While on exchange, students not only experience the diversity of educational settings, course offerings and philosophies, but also develop an increased awareness of cultural and geographical differences within the U.S. and Canada and a better understanding of their own academic, professional, and personal goals.

If you feel a need to grow personally, academically, culturally, and socially, if you are adaptable to a short-term change, if you have the individual responsibility to follow through with commitments, and if your personal goals are consistent with the purpose of the NSE program, read on.

Qualifications

The minimum requirements for application are:

1. current full-time (12 credits or more) enrollment at IPFW
2. cumulative overall GPA of at least 2.5
3. completion of at least 24 semester credits by the time of exchange
4. sophomore or junior standing at the time of exchange is best*

* Exchange may not be within 30 hours of graduation unless department/school approval is granted.

Campus Selection

There are more than 190 college and university campuses to choose from in the U.S., Canada, and the U.S. Territories. Selecting the right exchange college or university can be both challenging and time-consuming, as you attempt to become better acquainted with the curriculum, geography, and cultural options offered by different institutions. The NSE coordinator maintains a library of NSE catalogs and other public relations materials to help you identify those colleges and universities most compatible with your goals for participation in NSE. Also, visit the NSE Web site at www.nse.org for help in selecting the right exchange campus for you.

Course Credit

An advising agreement helps you determine specifically which classes will transfer back to IPFW and which requirements will be filled by the transferred credits. You will meet with the NSE coordinator during the summer before your exchange to complete the agreement and seek approval from your academic advisor.

Costs

Tuition/fees assessed are the in-state (resident) rates of the home (IPFW) campus. You must pay for room, board, and transportation to the host campus. Financial aid and scholarships are applicable except for the Federal Work Study program. Any additional fees charged by the host schools will be listed at: www.nse.org under "Campus Detail Info."

Student Placements

Applicants for each institution are prioritized by the IPFW NSE coordinator based upon the application. Placements are negotiated for the various campuses at a national NSE coordinator conference in March.

Application Information

Attend an information session or make an appointment with the NSE coordinator during December or January to discuss the application and other information. Application forms for NSE may be submitted in January and February. Freshmen are eligible to apply after receiving their first semester grades. An application fee of \$175 (non-refundable) is assessed with submission of the application.

The application deadline for the 2009–2010 academic year is Feb. 27, 2009. Applications will be accepted beginning Jan. 5, 2009.
