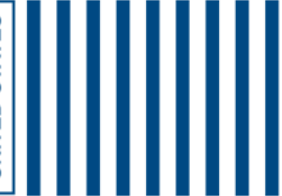

IPFW faculty submit progress alerts the 6th and 11th weeks of each semester to monitor your performance in the classroom. An ASAP! coach will review the progress alerts and help you improve.
