

**Call for Applications**  
**2010 IPFW Summer Faculty Grants for Research**  
**Application Deadline: October 8, 2009**

**Eligibility and Award Information**

- 1.) Applicants must hold tenured or tenure-track positions and may not be pursuing at the time of application a terminal degree required for the held position. Faculty with 12-month appointments are not eligible.
- 2.) Preference is given to applicants who have not received internal and/or external funding for salary within the past five years.
- 3.) Applications for grants-in-aid, course or teaching laboratory development will not be accepted.
- 4.) If eligible to do so, applicants should apply to both the IPFW and PRF summer grant programs.
- 5.) The award provides a taxable stipend of \$8,000 without fringe benefits to support two months of uninterrupted scholarly research by IPFW faculty.

Acceptance of a Summer Grant for Research implies that you will not be involved in other employment during the award period.

**Selection Process**

Ten IPFW Summer Grants are awarded each year. At least six of the ten IPFW grants will be awarded to junior (within the first three years of a tenured or tenure-track appointment) faculty. IPFW summer grants not reserved for junior faculty will be open to all eligible faculty members who have applied.

Using the evaluation criteria attached, The Professional Development Subcommittee makes recommendation to the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, who then makes the final awards. IPFW and PRF applications are considered together.

**Application**

- 1) The attached cover page must be used.
- 2) Use the information contained in the attached Assessment Form to develop your narrative.
- 3) The narrative portion is limited to five double-spaced pages using a type no smaller than 12 point.

- 4) Include the **following sections** in your narrative: abstract; statement of the problem; significance of the problem; a plan of research.
- 5) Include a curriculum vita of **no more** than two-pages.
- 6) Provide complete citations.
- 7) Pages for the vita and citations are in addition to the five-page narrative.
- 8) Do not include or provide letters of reference.
- 9) Two copies, one with original signatures, are required. **COPIES MUST BE COLLATED and PAPER CLIPPED: DO NOT STAPLE COPIES.**

**Completed applications must be submitted to ORES no later than**

**2:00 p.m. Thursday, October 8, 2009**

**Late applications will not be accepted.**

**Provide two collated copies, one with original signatures.**

**Do not staple copies.**
