HOW TO GET STARTED ON THE A.A. DEGREE

IF YOU HAVE ENROLLED AT IPFW DURING THE LAST YEAR:

If you are already an Arts and Sciences student, please come to the school office (CM 153) to declare the A.A. as your degree objective.

If you are not an Arts and Sciences student, please obtain a copy of your records from the registrar (KT 107) and bring it to the school office (CM 153) where you may declare the A.A. as your degree objective.

IF YOU ARE NOT CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT IPFW:

If you are attending another campus of Indiana University or Purdue University, you should fill out an intercampus transfer form and indicate the A.A. as your degree objective.

If you are a former student of IPFW or Indiana University or Purdue University but have not been enrolled for 12 or more months, you should complete the application form, mark re-entry as your status, and submit it to the Admissions office (KT 112). Please indicate the A.A. as your degree objective.

If you are a new student, you should apply for admission and indicate the A.A. as your degree objective.
