SUBJECT: Funding for the Fine Arts Building

DISPOSITION: To the Presiding officer for action

WHEREAS, Facilities for the fine arts at Indiana University-Purdue University at Fort Wayne are generally deplorable, and

WHEREAS, The present fine arts facilities are located several miles from the IPFW Coliseum Boulevard campus, thus isolating the department and its programs from the rest of the campus, and

WHEREAS, The state legislature has appropriated insufficient funding for a fine arts building on the Fort Wayne campus,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fort Wayne Senate believes that the proposed fine arts facility should be located on the Coliseum Boulevard campus of Indiana University-Purdue University at Fort Wayne, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Fort Wayne Senate believes that the fine arts facility should be fully funded from state appropriations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Fort Wayne Senate recognizes President Beering's efforts to secure state appropriations for the proposed fine arts building on the Fort Wayne campus, and asks President Beering to continue his efforts by making full and proper appropriations for this building a high-priority request to the legislature at the 1986 session.
