Tapestry Parkview Health Sciences Scholarships Taking Applications

Applications are now being accepted for two Tapestry Parkview Health Sciences Scholarships which will be awarded in 2009, each for a full year's tuition, up to \$7,000. The deadline for applications is Feb. 4, 2009. This competitive, merit-based scholarship was established in 2002 to provide assistance to IPFW students who have been accepted to the Nursing or Radiography programs. It is open to students accepted to the Nursing or Radiography programs who will be continuing their education in the Fall 2009 semester.

Eligibility requirements are:

- Female
- Accepted to either the Nursing or Radiography undergraduate professional healthcare programs in the College of Health and Human Services at IPFW
- Completed 28 credit hours
- Maintains an IPFW PROGRAM GPA of 3.3 or better. (A program grade point average is calculated using only those courses required for the degree.)

Tapestry - A Day for Women will be held Friday, April 24, 2009 at the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum. The scholarship winners will be recognized during the lunch program.
